You will start to see orange tags on the offending trees and brush growing into the roads and road easements, Please trim them now. Make sure you look at the whole tree or bush and cut them back to clear the road easement 10 feet from the edge of the road asphalt and 13 feet 6 inches above it. This makes roads safer for travel, and helps reduce fire fuel by the roadsides. Please remove the cut debris as well. Also, insurance companies are starting to cancel policies for homeowners living in dangerous fire areas, as well as canceling policies for homeowners that live next to a property that is not fire safe!! Now that we are getting rain remember to remove debris near your creeks and culverts. Clogged culverts cause flooding which damages the roads and your property.
