1. At the September 17 meeting the Board approved hiring a tree company to trim the dangerous tree limbs and branches hanging over the roads and road easements in the District. The Board wishes to **Thank** those residents who faithfully cut back their tree limbs, branches, and brush which improves visibility and helps reduce fire fuel near the roads and saves the District more money that will go toward road repair! **Update:** The District hired HG Tree Service to trim tree limbs and brush from Cameron and Flying C Roads. HG Tree Service did an <u>awesome</u> job!! These roads are much safer to drive, bike, walk and ride horses.

2. The Board approved hiring Wilsons Asphalt Inc., to crack seal and stripe Flying C Road to Cameron Road, and crack seal all of Cameron Road. **Update:** The work is complete and will preserve the life of Cameron and Flying C Roads and striping adds safety to Flying C Road by defining the lanes.
