 - Additional Asphalt on the exit side at the Upper Flying C gate,
 - Asphalt Repair on Trails End,
 - Shore up the culvert near 5170 Highcrest.

BOARD DIRECTOR POSITIONS OPEN

Please consider running for the office of Board Director for our District. **There will be 3 openings for the November 2026 election:** Three full term positions that will expire 12/06/2030. Road construction experience is not needed but is helpful. The CECSD consists of a 5-member board whose primary authority is the construction and maintenance of the roadways and easements. Board meetings occur bimonthly and board members are paid \$80 per regular meeting. It does not cost anything to run for the position and you will be given training if elected.

EID High-Pressure Sewer Line Project

- EID has plans to begin the high-pressure sewer line this September beginning near the Flying C Bridge.
- The Mozingo Construction Company plans to trench approximately 600 feet per day for EID.
- There will be 7 Air Release Valves (ARVs) along the new sewer force main. These valves automatically release trapped air and sewer gases that accumulate inside the pressurized pipeline.
