#### **Notices From the Board of Directors**

**1.** The District is looking to hire a Handyman for various maintenance jobs. Must have a Handyman license. If interested, contact Karen at the District office (530) 677-5889.

**2. Please do not tape** notices to the gate pillars! The glue from the tape leaves residue on the stones which damages the finish. Call the District office to borrow an A frame to display your signs. If we find signs taped to the pillars they will be removed!

**3**. Summer is coming! It is time to start cutting back trees and brush from the road easements for fire prevention and driver, pedestrian and equestrian safety. Check the easement in front of your property and <u>Please</u> keep your trees, brush and weeds trimmed back from the road and road easements. Make sure all are cut back to clear the easement 10 ft from the edge of the road and 13 ft 6 inches above it, and remove the cut debris as well.
