3. Spring is here! It is time to think about cutting back trees and brush from the road easements for fire prevention and driver, pedestrian and equestrian safety. Check the easement in front of your property and <u>Please</u> keep your trees, brush and weeds trimmed back from the road and road easements. Make sure all are cut back to clear the easement 10 ft from the edge of the road and 13 ft 6 inches above it, and remove the cut debris as well.
