Dangerous Fire Season Now Year Round!

As we are all well aware of the wildfires throughout California, **please** clear the recommended 100' defensible space around your homes. Also, trim your trees and brush back from the roads and road easements. Make sure you look at the whole tree or bush and cut them back to clear the road easement 10' from the edge of the road asphalt and 13' 6" above it. Be sure to remove the cut debris as well. Insurance companies are starting to cancel policies for homeowners living in dangerous fire areas, as well as **canceling policies** for homeowners living **next to property that is not fire safe!!** Visit <u>http://www.preventwildfireca.org/</u> for valuable information on wildfire prevention and <u>safety tips while cutting weeds.</u>

Temporary Gate Code for Events

If you are having a large event, or work done on your property, the District office can issue you a temporary gate entrance code to give to your gardener, contractor or guests. Call the District office to arrange for a temporary code.

Notices From the Board of Directors

1. Please do not tape notices to the gate pillars! The glue from the tape leaves residue on the stones which damages the finish. Call the District office to borrow an A frame to display your signs. If we find signs taped to the pillars they will be removed!

2. We are finally getting rain! Please check the culverts, swales and ditches on your property near the roads to make sure they are clear of debris and will allow water to flow freely to the creeks and off the road. If they are clogged clear them! If they remain clogged, rain water flows over the roads causing much damage to the roads!
