President Thomson called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m. Board Secretary, Joy Reggiardo, conducted roll call. Director Thomson, Director Panages, Director Carter, and Director King were in attendance. Director Reese was absent.

4. **Guest Speaker from Cameron Estates Watch Group**
A member of Cameron Estates Watch Group will speak to the Board and will summarize the activities and goals of CECSW Watch.

Lynn Kissel from Cameron Estates Watch spoke about what Watch does for Cameron Estates. Watch assists with alerts for safety concerns. For the coming year, Watch hopes to improve the use of the CECSW gate cameras and include more of residents' cameras to assist with suspicious activity. Lynn spoke about the Utah State and EDC mountain lion study. The lions are most active dawn and dusk. A male mountain lion has a 300 square mile territory. Lynn said the best deterrent is to lock your livestock up at night. The passive deterrents were not effective. Lions are less afraid of humans since we don't shoot them anymore. Mountain lions are a protected species, but you are allowed to protect yourself. Residents should notify EDC fish and game as soon as there is an incident so the trapper can track them with hounds. A study shows that prey animals live close to humans for protection.

Director Panages discussed the recent asphalt work from Veerkamp construction. There was an issue with the asphalt on Brookside Rd., but Veerkamp put a slurry seal on it, will sand slurry it in the fall, and will guarantee the job for two years. The Directors discussed the X's on the road for drone surveillance. The District believes P.G.& E. might put poles underground, but can't verify that information yet. The Board discussed potholes and the expense. The General Manager said a lot of the money spent is for asphalt supplies. A resident said the roads are looking better now that we are not waiting a year before potholing again. E.I.D. plans to go forward with the high-pressure sewer line but is not cooperating with us. The General Manager and Board President will meet with the EID Board representative and Project Engineer on 6/3.
